Malbec 'Finca la Colonia Colección', Bodega Norton - £9

With vineyards at 1200m altitude, Argentinean wines are naturally organic.

Malbec, the country's best red grape, is full, berryish and smooth.

Red Wine - Australia

Shiraz 'The Long Paddock', Redbank, Victoria - £10.50

A fruity, supple red with blackcurrant fruit and spice flavours.

Classic Aussie red and very drinkable, from the cooler King Valley, north of Melbourne.

Shiraz Viognier, Yalumba, Barossa Valley - £12

This legendary winery produces intense Shiraz with cassis and flavours with 5% white Viognier to lift the wine, a very fashionable winemaking technique.

The grape is perfect in the hot, dry vineyards, and is known for peppery wine.

Cabernet Sauvignon Merlot, Vasse Felix, Western Australia - £13.50

Perfumed with spicy cassis flavours and aromas.

Vasse Felix was the first commercial winery in Margaret River, WA, and is a top quality estate.

Pinot Noir, Lethbridge, Victoria - £14.50

A small boutique winery, in the cool valleys north of Melbourne.

This is perfect for the development of the refined, elegant, supple flavours of Pinot Noir.

Delicious, summer pudding fruit flavours.

Red Wine - Chile

Cabernet Sauvignon, Siete Soles Estate - £8

*This classic grape and winery produce dense, dark, deep blackcurrant flavours with a smoky, woody edge.
A very good food wine.*

Merlot, De Martino - £8.50

*This noted estate makes full, ripe Merlot, reminiscent of plums and spice
with a smooth, warming, gentle oaky finish.*

Carmenère Reserva, Viña Santa Rita - £10.50

*This producer is highly respected for the grape Carmenère, a 'lost' Bordeaux grape, now reborn in Chile.
A soft, delicious dark wine, packed with red and black fruit flavours, with a fresh cherry finish.*

Red Wine - France

Syrah, Vin de Pays d'Oc, Georges Duboeuf - £8.50

Duboeuf has an international reputation for textbook wines of high quality. His Syrah is medium bodied, packed with black fruit flavours and is very Drinkable. Duboeuf intends 'vin de plaisir'.

Pinot Noir, Vin de Pays d'Oc, Les Templiers - £9

From near Montpellier, the warm climate vineyards suit the delicate Pinot Noir grape, and allows the medium bodied, gentle flavours of the wine. Soft and berryish.

Château Haut-Bréga, Haut-Médoc, Bordeaux - £11.50

The great wine village, north of Bordeaux. Flavours of cassis, spice and wood combine to produce a wine of great class. Haut-Bréga has a good reputation.

Rully 'Les Chaponnières', Henri et Paul Jacqueson - £16

One of the most famous wine villages in the Chalonnaise region of Burgundy. 100% Pinot Noir, barrel fermented for rich, smooth red fruit flavours. Jacquesson is considered to be one of superstar growers.

Fleurie, Clos des Quatre Vents - £13

The classic medium bodied red of France, from the Gamay grape and the master Beaujolais producer, Duboeuf. Delicious strawberry flavours, with a soft, gentle style. Very drinkable.

Crozes-Hermitage 'Les Launes', Delas Frères - £14.50

100% Syrah, intensely dark fruit, refined by oak ageing, from a great Rhône producer, recently reviewed as a 'class act.'

Minervois 'L'Opéra', Château Villerambert-Julien - £11

The classic wine of the Western Languedoc region from a blend of Grenache, Syrah and Mourvèdre. Power and suppleness, softness and strength are the ambitions of this 16th Century estate.

Red Wine - Italy

Chianti Superiore 'Santa Cristina', Antinori - £12.50

*Rich and intensely fruity, packed with ripe cherry fruit and a herb-like, long finish.
Antinori is one of Tuscany's greats, established in 1385.*

Rosso di Montepulciano 'Sabazio', La Braccasca, Tuscany - £12

La Braccasca is a winery to watch and an increasingly important player in this famous appellation, south east of Chianti. Gentle, moreish, Sangiovese flavours with body, depth and power.

Nero d'Avola 'Regaleali', Tasca d'Almerita, Sicily - £12

*Full bodied and robust red full of black cherry flavours.
Tasca, a noble family of centuries of winemaking tradition,
is regarded as one of the top 2 wineries on the island.*

Barbera d'Asti 'Fiilot', Prunotto - £11.50

*A classic grape variety from the northwest near Turin.
Gentle, soft, supple red and black fruit flavours from a prestigious, 5* grower.*

Merlot, Coopers Creek, Hawkes Bay - £11.50

Coopers Creek, established in the 1980's.

It is known for soft, smooth Merlots from the celebrated North Island region. Plummy fruit and a silky finish.

Pinot Noir, Matakana Estate, Marlborough - £13

Marlborough is known as one of the best sources of Pinot Noir outside France.

Fragrant and elegant with cherry and plum fruit flavours.

Matakana scores 4/5 in New Zealand wine guides.

Pinotage, Kleinkloof - £9

*The best region in the world for this deep, dark, spicy grape with a smoky edge,
perfect with roasted red meats.*

Tempranillo, Finca Antigua, La Mancha - £10.50

*One of the most admired new Spanish wineries from scorching La Mancha, near Madrid.
Silky-smooth and full of wild strawberry and pepper flavours.*

Rioja Crianza, Conde de Valdemar - £12

Smooth flavours of black cherry and plum. Valdemar is a 5 winery, according
to all critics, known for superb aged Riojas with the classic oaky flavours.*

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
